- Review of International Guidelines ASPEN 2016 and ESPEN 2018 in critically ill patients

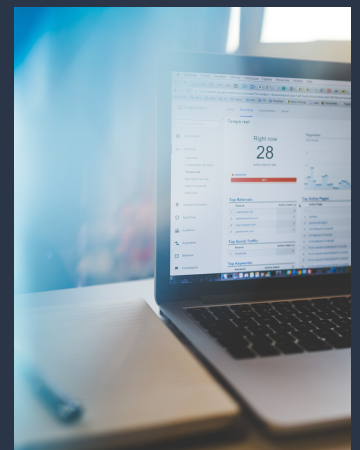
PROGRAM

DEMOGRAPHY

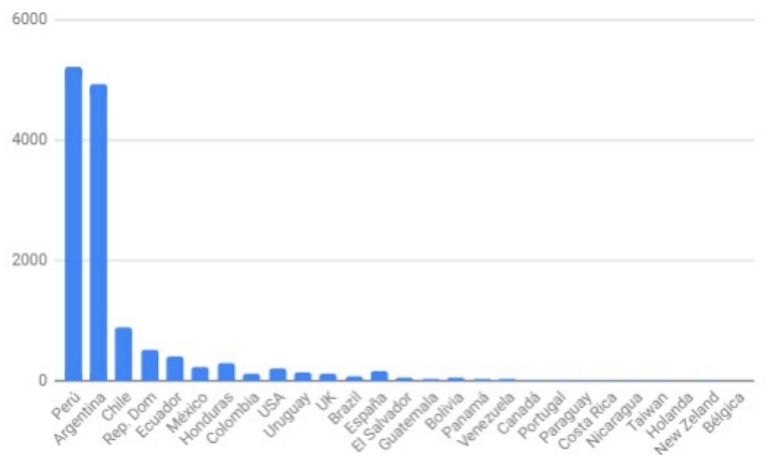
The Congress has **1,380** registered as of June 16, 2020.

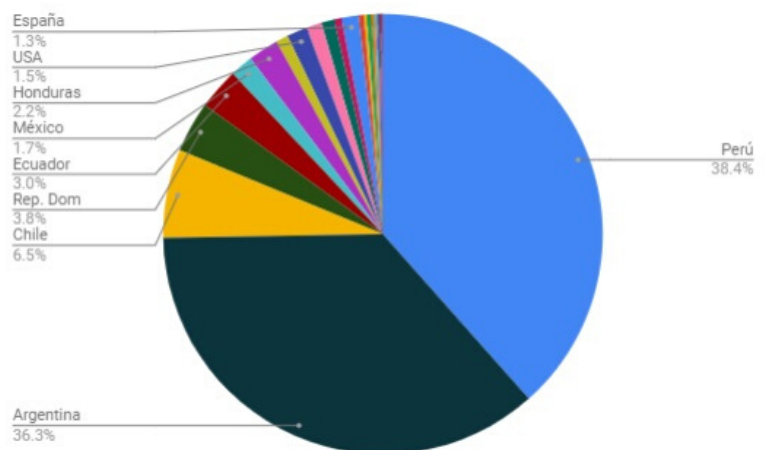
DEMOGRAPHY PERCENTAGE

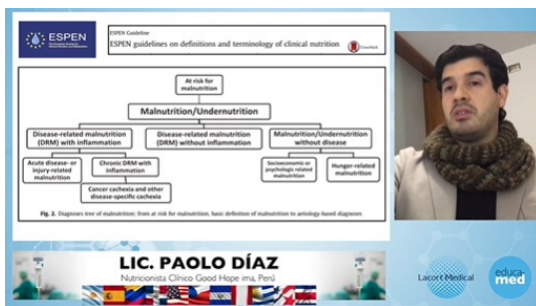

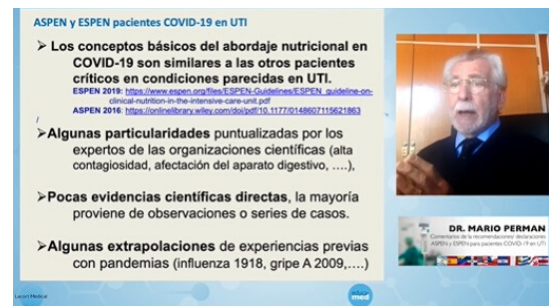
